Minutes: A motion was made by Ken to approve the May 11, 2015 meeting minutes, second by Pete; motion carried.

1. Commitment for the Village of Hewitt/Town of Marshfield for the Connector Trail Phase 1 Project is \$ 6,750 for 2013 DNR Grant (pay in 2015).
2. Commitment for the Village of Hewitt/Town of Marshfield for the Connector Trail Phase 2 Project is \$ 30,000 for 2014 DNR Grant (pay \$15,000 in 2015 and \$15,000 in 2016).

- Update on the 2013 & 2014 DNR connector trail project:
 - No new information was shared
- New Boardwalk Construction
 - Construction date scheduled for Saturday July 11th @ 8:00 AM at Draxler's lot on 9th Street. A placing crew of 5 - 6 people is desired. Ken to post on Facebook to see if we can get any community members to assist.
 - Kevin to pick up from Menards when on sale: 100ea. 2"x6"x10' SPF, 25ea. 2"x4" x 10' SPF, 49ea. 5/4"x6"x8' treated decking, deck screws, bundle of cedar shakes, and bottled water. Materials to be delivered to Mike Draxler's home. Mike will cut materials in preparation to the construction date.

New business

- Communication from Town Board meeting: None
- Communication from Village Board meeting: None
- Business not anticipated in advance:

- It was suggested to remove the trash containers on the trail system and move them to the park. The trash containers have signs stating that the use is not for pet waste, however that is what they have been used for. Kevin will move them to the park.
- Discussion took place about blacktopping the trail from 3rd Street to 7th Street. Ballpark estimate based on other recent project \$24,000 for a 10' wide path, 2" thick x 1600' long.
