- Update on the 2013 & 2014 DNR connector trail project:
  - Project was awarded to Earth, Inc.
  - Dump road will be used to access construction site
  - Town property to be stored on Town of Marshfield property during construction
  - Project completion by the end of August 2015 for Phase 1 and Phase 2
- New Boardwalk Construction
  - Construction date scheduled for Saturday July 23rd @ 6:30 AM at Draxler's at the trail boardwalk. Mike Draxler has the 5/4 material cut.
  - Pete to inquire about more railroad ties and also sending pictures to Felkers and the Railroad with a letter taking them for their donation to the boardwalk project.
