Public Hearing called to order at 7:00p.

Welcome: Jeff Graves welcomed approximately 25 members of the community for the purpose of providing an update on the process of developing a comprehensive plan, community survey update, and a forum for public input. Planning Committee members were introduced along with Wood County Planner, Jason Grueneberg.

Jason reviewed the requirements by the Village of Hewitt to implement a Comprehensive Plan with participation by the community. Completion of the Plan is anticipated in August 2011. A survey was mailed to all Village residents with approximately 55% returned. That is a very impressive response rate that shows a strong concern for the future of our community. Preliminary results of the survey were shared with those present. For the most part, no significant issues were discovered from the survey.

3. Availability of grants for community enhancements.
