ORDINANCE 19.01 – 1983
PARKING

The Village Board of the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin hereby ordains an ordinance to govern parking within the Village of Hewitt boundary limits as follows:

SECTION 1 - PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish rules and regulations governing parking in public places, winter parking and parking restrictions within the Village of Hewitt boundaries.

SECTION 2 – DEFINITIONS:

PARKING: Parking is defined to mean permitting a vehicle to remain unattended, but shall not include the temporary stopping of a vehicle by a physician on an emergency call, a business vehicle being used for normal delivery or pickup, police, fire or other emergency vehicles.

WINTER MONTHS: Winter months are defined as the period November 1st through April 1st of the calendar year.

SNOW EMERGENCY: Snow emergency is defined as the period whenever there is an accumulation of snow greater than three (3) inches during a 24-hour period and such accumulation hinders or interferes with the safe and expeditious movement of traffic or impedes the ability of an emergency or public transportation vehicle to travel safely and expeditiously over the streets and highways of the Village of Hewitt.

PUBLIC PROPERTY: Public property is defined as owned by the Village of Hewitt and not by any person or private entity used by the general public. Such property has either been acquired by the Village of Hewitt using tax dollars and/or donations designated specifically to the Village of Hewitt. In addition, public tax dollars are used by the Village of Hewitt to maintain said property.

SECTION 3 – PARKING/STORAGE IN PUBLIC PLACES:

- No person shall park any vehicle or obstruction on public property belonging to the Village of Hewitt, except in designated parking places, or park or allow any vehicle to stand on any public property in the Village of Hewitt whether occupied or unoccupied between the hours of 1:00 to 6:00 AM.
- No person shall store any personal property such as vehicles, campers, boats, or trailers on public property, streets or buildings belonging to the Village of Hewitt.
- No person shall place or store any personal property not listed above on public property, streets or buildings belonging to the Village of Hewitt.

SECTION 4 – SNOW DEPOSIT ON VILLAGE STREETS:

- It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to deposit snow from private premises, whether his own or those belonging to any other private person, business or corporation upon any sidewalk, street, or other private or Village property within the Village of Hewitt.

SECTION 5 – PARKING RESTRICTIONS:

- *Village Streets* – Parking is **prohibited** on the **Even side** of all Village Streets with the following exceptions:
 - *Yellowstone Drive* – Parking is **prohibited** on **both sides** of Yellowstone Drive from the intersection of County Highway T (Main Street Hewitt) West to the Village limits.
 - *Parking is prohibited on any street where no parking signs exist.*
- *Winter Months* – No vehicle shall be parked on any public street or highway in the Village of Hewitt during the hours of 1:00 AM – 6:00 AM - November 1st through April 1st.
- *Snow Emergency* – No vehicle shall be parked on any public street or highway at any time within the Village of Hewitt limits during snow emergency conditions. Such emergency shall be in effect for a period of 48-hours after snow has ceased to fall or until such time as the snow has been removed from the streets and/or highways within the Village of Hewitt to allow for the safe and expeditious movement of traffic.
 - *Declaration of Snow Emergency* – A snow emergency shall be declared to exist as defined in Section 2 of this Ordinance. Public announcement of such an emergency shall be courteous in nature only and not a duty on the part of the Village Road Commissioner.

SECTION 6 – PENALTIES:

- Any person, business or corporation or other not specifically listed who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$10.00 or more than \$100.
- Any vehicle that receives a parking citation and is not moved within 24-hours will be towed at the owner's expense.

SECTION 7 – EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance as amended shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
