REGULATIONS FOR THE STORAGE OF UNLICENSED AND/OR JUNKED MOTORIZED VEHICLES

An ordinance to establish regulations for the storage of unlicensed and/or junked motorized vehicles within the Village of Hewitt.

The Village Board of the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 - PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the parking and storage of unlicensed and/or junked motorized vehicles and parts thereof within the Village of Hewitt.

SECTION 2 - EXTENT OF REGULATION

- A. No person, firm, partnership or corporation shall accumulate or store unlicensed or junked motorized vehicles or parts thereof, outside any building on any real estate located within the corporate limits of the Village of Hewitt, except by permit issued by the Village Board.
- B. The permit issued by the Village Board, shall be signed by the Village President and/or Clerk, and shall specify the quantity and manner of storing such unlicensed or junked vehicles or parts thereof. Such permit shall be revocable at any time by the Village Board when it is found that the permit holder has failed or refused to comply with the restrictions or regulations set forth in the permit.
- C. This ordinance shall not apply to motor vehicle dealers licensed under the provisions of Wisconsin State Statutes.

REGULATIONS FOR THE STORAGE OF UNLICENSED AND/OR JUNKED
MOTORIZED VEHICLES

SECTION 3 - ENFORCEMENT


Upon notification and/or observation to/by the Village Board that unlicensed and/or junked motorized vehicles, or parts thereof, are being stored within the corporate limits of the Village as defined in Section 2-A, the Village Clerk shall cause notice to be served upon the owner or occupant of the premises, upon which the vehicle or part thereof is being stored or parked, that compliance with this ordinance must be made within five (5) days after such notice is served.

SECTION 4 - PENALTIES

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance or fail to comply with the notification of violation, shall forfeit not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) initially and for each day that said person is in violation of this ordinance, shall forfeit five dollars (\$5.00) per day until compliance is made.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication as requested by law.
