WHEREAS, the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin is responsible for ward division and designating polling places in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and


WHEREAS, the Village of Hewitt made and passed a motion to designate the Village of Hewitt to have one ward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Hewitt Board does hereby create one ward as follows:

Ward One – All properties located within the Village of Hewitt boundaries that fall within Wood County Supervisor District No. 6 (as designated on the attached map).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward will be combined, using one common polling place, which is the Town of Marshfield Hall located at Main Street, Hewitt, WI 54441. The polling place, as required by law, is located in Ward One (1).

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
