Hewitt Area Recreation Department Minutes

Date: Tuesday – May 17, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM at the Hewitt Administrative Building.

The minutes from the meeting held on April 19, 2016 were reviewed. Angel Denk made a motion to approve as written, second by Derek Freis. Motion Carried.

The financial report for May 17, 2016 was reviewed; ending balance \$25,406.47. A motion to accept the financial report was made by Amanda Renkas, second by Karen Tritz. Motion Carried.

Old Business

2016 Softball & Volleyball Season

- Umpires are needed for the 12-14 year old league; Score keeper is needed for the 9-11 year old league.
- Food Stand – coolers are now in; pop machine will be removed.
- Raffle letters for prizes will be sent out soon.
- Picture day is Tuesday May 31, 2016.
- We have a total of 422 kids signed up for this season. Rosters have been finalized and shirts have been ordered. Volleyball has 10 teams, each team has an opening for one additional player, and extra shirts were ordered for each team with no name on the back.
- There was discussion on whether or not we should be accepting registrations after the May 1st deadline date for softball. May 1st has always been set as the deadline date so we could get the rosters done and shirts ordered. If we allowed registrations after that date it would be impossible to have everything ready by the first softball night. A motion to not accept softball registrations after the May 1 deadline was made by Jeremy Denk, second by Cheryl Uthmeier. Motion Carried.

New Business

- First aid kit is usually loaned out from the Hewitt Area Fire Department each year. We do keep our own supply of Band-Aids in the food stand.
- We discussed funds for potential projects. A motion was made by Derek Freis that we pay for the stainless gates and cedar rail fencing for the trail by the park, second by Scott McConnell. Motion Carried.
- There was discussion on purchasing a new wireless scoreboard control. Motion by Deb Lang, second by Karen Tritz to purchase a new wireless scoreboard control for the 12 – 14 year old field. Motion Carried.
- All other projects can be discussed at our next meeting. We will then have a better idea as to how much money we can donate to other potential projects.
- A new chairperson will be needed for the 2017 softball season.

- Wood Chucks Camp that was to be held on Sunday, June 26, 2016 has been cancelled due to a miscommunication.
