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# Hewitt Area Recreation Department Minutes

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Date: Tuesday – June 21, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 9:03 PM at the Yellowstone Recreation Park.

The minutes from the meeting held on May 17, 2016 were reviewed. Matt Metcalf made a motion to approve as written, second by Deahlee Tritz. Motion Carried.

The financial report for June 21, 2016 was reviewed; ending balance \$25,541.57. A motion to accept the financial report was made by John Phillippi, second by Chris Mueller. Motion Carried.

## Old Business

### 2016 Softball & Volleyball Season

- All leagues reported the season is going good. More help is needed from the parents in the 9 – 11 year old league during the games.
- New bats will purchased for the 12 – 14 year old league. This league suggested that we hang signs that designates which is the home team and the guest team.
- Raffle tickets will be printed up soon.
- Team and individual pictures will be taken on Sunday, July 17, 2016. This is the makeup night for the game that was rained out on May 31, 2016.
- There was discussion on what projects the Hewitt Area Recreation Department should help fund. Motion by Scott Wunrow, second by Marlene Kappel to designated \$5,000.00 to Phase III of the walking trail. Motion Carried. Three other items on the proposed project lists that we felt would be good projects to fund were: Blacktop parking lot; Install a Gaga Pit; Refurbish shelter building into a picnic area at the 'old' Hewitt Ball Park located at 7654 Mclean Ln. Each member at this meeting took a piece of paper and voted on which of these items they would like to see done first, second and third.

The results of this vote were as follows:

- 1st - Designate \$5,000.00 to refurbish the shelter building at the 'old' ball park.
- 2nd - Install a Gaga Pit
- 3rd - Blacktop Parking Lot

## New Business

- A few items that need to be done after this season is fill in the ruts and holes and level out the 7 – 9 year old field. Have new locks but on the storage shed or re-key the existing locks.
- We discussed what we can do to recruit new members. Emails will be sent out letting parents know that we need active members to continue the softball & volleyball program. Marlene will have signs printed up to hang near the food stand.

- The next issue and a very important one is that we will need a new chairperson for next year. Please let Jenni Heeg know if you are interested in this position.
- Tournament schedules will be set up by each league.
- Food for the tournament will be similar to the previous years.
- Invitations will be sent out to the Sponsors for the coaches and workers party that is held after the tournament. Members are reminded to bring a dish to pass.
- Awards and trophies will be given out at the tournament.
- The Keding Memorial Award and the Updyke Memorial Award will be presented after the tournament. Each coach in the 11-14 year old softball league (Keding Award) and each coach in the 9-11 year old softball league (Updyke Award) chooses someone from their team who they feel has shown the best sportsmanship during the softball season. These names are then put in a drawing for the awards.
- Ken Eilers will use our large tent for a wedding at Yellowstone Park in August.
