

## **PARKING ON VILLAGE STREETS**

- No overnight parking on Village Streets November 1 - April 1 of calendar year.
- No overnight parking at the end of dead end streets.
- No overnight parking at Village parks
- Snow Emergencies - No parking on Village Streets at any time; subject to towing & resulting costs.
- Snowmobiles & ATV's are prohibited on Village streets.

## **FIREARMS**

The use of firearms within the Village of Hewitt is strictly prohibited.

- Bow & Arrow target practice on one's own property may be permitted providing a permit is obtained from the Village Clerk and compliance with regulations as set forth in Ordinance #20.02-1984.

## **SANITARY (SEWER) SERVICE**

A fee is charged to each residence receiving sanitary sewer service. The Village of Hewitt has established a mandatory ordinance that any resident within the Village of Hewitt boundaries must be hooked up to the Village of Hewitt sewer system. Residents outside the Village of Hewitt limits are prohibited to hookup to the system without annexing their property to the Village.

- Sump pumps are required for all residences. Discharge shall not flow, seep, run or drain onto adjoining property and cannot be discharged into the Village sewer system.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**


- It is prohibitive to park or store an unlicensed vehicle outside any building on any real estate within the Village of Hewitt.
- Curfew/Loitering - The Village of Hewitt enforces a curfew for those under the age of 16 on streets, parks, playgrounds, etc.
- Transient Merchants, Solicitors, are required to have a permit to sell door-to-door within the Village of Hewitt. Charitable organizations are exempt.

## **BUILDING PERMITS**

The Village of Hewitt requires a building permit for any work in excess of \$1,000 value. Contact Al Breu (387-4222) for detailed information and/or to obtain a permit.

## **GOVERNMENT**

The Village of Hewitt is governed by an elected board consisting of a President, four trustees and an appointed clerk/treasurer.

If you wish to have an item placed on the agenda, please contact President Ken Eilers or Village Clerk/Treasurer Marlene Stueland.

## **GARBAGE DISPOSAL**

The Village of Hewitt contracts with a refuse company for weekly curbside pickup of residential garbage as follows:

- Frequency: Weekly
- Day: Thursday
- Time: Garbage should not be placed curbside prior to the evening before scheduled pickup.
- Guidelines: Clear colorless plastic bags must be used.

## **RECYCLING**

The Village of Hewitt has a mandatory recycling program for all Village residents.

One (1) recycling container is provided free of charge to each Village household. To obtain a container, contact the Village Clerk.

Recyclable materials are collected on the same schedule as garbage and should be placed curbside for pickup.

## **RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES**

Recreational opportunities abound within the Village limits and include:

## **FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES**

Fire protection services are provided to the Village of Hewitt Area Fire Department. The main firehouse is located on McLean Drive. Open burning is prohibited.

- Outdoor wood burning stoves are prohibited
- Permits are required for fire pits - Contact Hewitt Fire Department (384-9449)

## **POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES**

The Wood County Sheriff's Department provides police protection to the Village.

## **DOGS**

Residents are required to license their dogs on an annual basis.

Contact Marlene Stueland for licensing your pet if you are a new resident in the Village.

Noteworthy dog regulations:

- Dogs running at large or untagged are subject to a fine and/or impoundment.
- No more than three (3) dogs per residence are permitted.
- Rabies vaccinations are required
- Pit bull dogs prohibited
