OLD BUSINESS:

- Christmas Party Review: The party was held on Sunday December 19, 2010 at the Buck-a-neer Supper Club in Rozellville. All agreed that the food and food choices were great as was the service. A good time was had by all that attended.
- Update on purchases: the bleachers have been purchased; curb work for the parking lot was installed; the racks for the bats have been ordered; a cheese dispenser will be purchased.
- The Fire Department received our donation of \$1,000.00 and sent us a thank you; the \$2,000.00 that was donated to the Village of Hewitt's website upgrade will be held until this project is started.

NEW BUSINESS:

Project Graduation:

She would like to have an open gym type atmosphere for volleyball. She would be willing to pay a fee, which would need to be discussed by the Village Board. We discussed the need to get a display case where people can look to see if the fields or courts have been reserved. More and more people are now using the fields, so this would be very helpful.
