ORDINANCE NO. 17.50

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE POSSESSION OR DRINKING OF MALT BEVERAGES

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, POSSESSION OR DRINKING OF MALT Beverages or intoxicating liquor on certain public places\* be prohibited as follows:

(a) General. It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his or her possession any open can, bottle or other container containing malt beverages or intoxicating liquor, or to drink from the same, on any public street, sidewalk, boulevard, parkway, safety zone, alley or public parking lot, or in any motor vehicle parked on a public street, alley or public parking lot.

(b) Exception. At such times and places as may be specifically exempted from the provisions of par (a) temporarily, from time to time, by order of the Village Board of Hewitt.

(c) Penalty. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be \$66.00 (sixty-six dollars) per violation per occurrence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and complying with the Wisconsin State regulations governing adoption of such Ordinance.
