Ordinance 2005-10
ROAD SIDE DITCH DRAIN TILING

The Village Board of the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin, does ordain:

SECTION 1 – INSTALLATION OF DRAIN TILE IN ROAD SIDE DITCHES

- (a) Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate how drain tile is installed in road side ditches and that proper ditch drainage is maintained within the Village of Hewitt.
- (b) Steps to be Taken: Village residents or business choosing to install drain tile within road side ditches must execute the following steps:
1. The village board must be notified of the proposed drain tile installation.
 2. The resident or business must submit written plans on the details of the drain tile installation within the road side ditch to the village clerk.
 3. The Roads Commissioner or Committee will review the plans and make a site visit.
 4. The Roads Commissioner or Committee will make a recommendation to the board to approve or deny the drain tile installation.
- (c) Action: The Village Board will take action on the drain tile installation request.
- (d) Cost: A fee of \$50.00 must be accompanied with the written plans that are submitted to the village clerk.

SECTION 2 - FINES


Failure to get approval by the Village of Hewitt Board before installing drain tile in a road side ditch will result in a fine of \$250.00 and removal of the installed drain tile at the village resident or business cost.

SECTION 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
