

RESOLUTION 2010-01

SHARING OF A SINGLE POLLING FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONDUCTING  
ELECTIONS BETWEEN THE

VILLAGE OF HEWITT  
AND  
TOWN OF MARSHFIELD

**WHEREAS**, the VILLAGE OF HEWITT, Wood County, Wisconsin is responsible for ward division and designation of polling places in the VILLAGE OF HEWITT and,

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the VILLAGE OF HEWITT Board that it is fiscally responsible to combine the polling location of the Village of Hewitt and the Town of Marshfield, to better serve constituents and promote good relations with neighboring municipalities, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Marshfield Board and the VILLAGE OF HEWITT Board have agreed to enter into an agreement to combine polling places, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Marshfield has agreed to allow VILLAGE OF HEWITT voters access to the Marshfield Town hall in the Town of Marshfield, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Marshfield has adopted Resolution #10-01 to allow voters of the VILLAGE OF HEWITT to vote at the town hall in the Town of Marshfield, and

**WHEREAS**, it is agreed upon that the VILLAGE OF HEWITT and the Town of Marshfield will share equally the cost of purchasing the vote tabulating machine and all costs for its maintenance.


