

ORDINANCE NO. 40.0

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE DIRECT ANNEXATION OF PART OF THE  
TOWN OF MARSHFIELD TO THE VILLAGE OF HEWITT

The Village Board of the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin,  
does hereby ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board of the Village of Hewitt  
have been petitioned to directly annex the following described property:

That part of the West One Half ( $W\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, lying South of  
the right-of-way of the Minneapolis St. Paul and Sault Ste. Marie  
Railway Company, the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest  
Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 3 East,  
the Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of  
Section 23, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, the Northwest  
Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23, Township  
25 North, Range 3 East, and that part of the Northeast Quarter  
( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13),  
Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Three (3) East, described  
as follows: commencing in the Southwest (SW) corner of said  
forty; thence North (N) Sixteen (16) rods; thence East (E) Ten (10)  
rods; thence South Sixteen (16) rods; thence West (W) Ten (10) rods  
to the place of beginning.

AND WHEREAS, the said petition for direct annexation has been  
signed by all of the electors residing in the above described territory and  
by the owners of all of the real property in such territory;

AND WHEREAS, the said petition together with a scale map and a  
description of the property to be annexed, showing the boundaries of such  
territory and the relationship of the territory to the municipalities to which  
annexation is requested, has been filed with the Clerk of the Village of

Hewitt, and with the Clerk of the Town of Marshfield, wherein the said territory is located, pursuant to Section 66.021 (12) of the Wisconsin Statutes;

AND WHEREAS, within five (5) days of the filing of the said petition with the Clerk of the Village of Hewitt a copy of the scale map and a description of the property to be annexed was mailed to the head of the planning function in the Department of Local Affairs and Development, pursuant to Section 66.021 (12) of the Wisconsin Statutes;

AND WHEREAS more than twenty (20) days have passed since the head of the planning function received the scale map and description of the land to be annexed; and the head of the planning function has not mailed notice to the Clerk of the Village of Hewitt or to the Clerk of the Town of Marshfield that in his opinion the annexation is against the public interest;

AND WHEREAS, sixty (60) days have not yet elapsed since the petition was filed with the Clerk of the Village of Hewitt;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Hewitt, Wood County, Wisconsin, does hereby annex to the Village of Hewitt from the Town of Marshfield, Wood County, Wisconsin, the following described territory:

That part of the West One Half ( $W\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, lying South of the right-of-way of the Minneapolis St. Paul and Saulte Ste. Marie Railway Company, the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, the Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 23, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, the Northwest Quarter ( $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter of Section 23, Township 25 North, Range 3 East, and that part of the Northeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Three (3) East, described as follows: commencing in the Southwest (SW) corner of said forty; thence North (N) Sixteen (16) rods, thence East (E) Ten (10) rods; thence South Sixteen (16) rods; thence West (W) Ten (10) rods to the place of beginning.
