Old Business

- All leagues reported that the season went well. Concession stand needs someone to do clean up after the games. The raffle went well. A big thank you to everyone who volunteered their time to help run this program.

New Business

- Motion by Matt Metcalf to donate \$250.00 for the HAFD 2019 Pumpkin Run, second by Anne Iwanski. Motion Carried.
- Motion by Cheryl Uthmeier to donate \$2,000.00 to the Village of Hewitt for 2020 park maintenance, second by Anne Iwanski. Motion Carried.
- The Holiday Party for members that volunteered in 2019 will be held January 11, 2020, a reminder email will be sent out in December.
- The tentative dates for the 2020 softball/volleyball season held every Tuesday evening starting at 5:30 PM: June 2 – July 28, 2020; Tournament weekend Friday July 31 and Saturday August 1, 2020. These dates may change depending when Hub City Days are scheduled in 2020.
- There was discussion on what we should spend our funds on for improvements at the park. Following is a list of expenses and tentative projects:

\$2,000.00 - 2020 donation for maintenance expenses for the Park

\$8,000.00 – curb install*

\$250.00 – 2019 HAFD Pumpkin Run

\$2,000.00 - estimate Holiday Party

\$6,000.00 – additional playground equipment

\$10,000.00 - 2020 season start up

*(depends on the cost - this was a tentative idea from last year for the curb installation along east side of the parking lot near the T-Ball Field.)
