OPEN BURNING

The Village of Hewitt Boards does hereby adopt the following guidelines as they relate to Open Burning in the Village of Hewitt, Hewitt, Wisconsin.

1. SIZE: The size of a pile of material to be burned shall not exceed 10' x 10' x 10'.
2. LOCATION: The material being burned shall be at least 50' from any structure, wood or lumber pile, wooden fence or brush. Material can be in an approved burner 15' from same.
3. MATERIAL FOR BURNING: Fuel for open burning shall consist of dry material only and shall not be ignited with flammable or combustible liquids. Material may not include products made or coated with rubber, plastic, or petroleum based materials and may not contain any flammable or combustible liquids.
4. SUPERVISION: Open burning shall be constantly attended by a competent person until such fire is extinguished. This person shall have available extinguishing equipment to put the fire out if needed.
5. PROHIBITION: Burning is not allowed on windy days or circumstances that makes the fire potentially hazardous.
6. TIME OF BURNING: After 6:00 P.M.
7. LIABILITY: If smoke or heat bothers anybody else the fire shall be extinguished.
8. PERMITS: Open burning is by permit only, issued by the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, or Fire Department Secretary.
