Roads Committee Minutes

Monday July 10th, 2017– 7:00 PM

1. Called to order at 7:00 P.M. in attendance Kris Hawley Chairman, Ken Rasmussen. Public guest Mike Draxler and Mike Morrissey.
2. General Street Maintenance:

Kris reported they no longer make the patching material that was purchased at Prince. Mike Draxler will get some cold mix patch from Doine's and round up a crew to get the major ones on Yellowstone and others throughout the village. Kris also said the City of Marshfield tried a new product from Sherwin Industries called "Aquaphalt" that has a 3 year warranty that is to be used to patch potholes. He will get a hold of the salesman for a demonstration.
3. Street Name Sign Replacement to conform to MUTCD:

The new street signs are all in the shelter building and Mike Draxler volunteered to finish putting them together with Dan Sova and install them. He also stated we should do a sign inventory and to get an idea of other signs that need to be replaced throughout the village.
4. Update of Yellowstone Drive Reconstruction:

Kris stated that the village will be applying for a 50/50 grant for the reconstruction of Yellowstone drive. With the help of MSA we will submit an application for the grant. He also stated that we need to approach the City of Marshfield and the Township of Marshfield to see if they were interested in redoing their stretches of Yellowstone Drive. Intergovernmental cooperation would increase our odds of receiving such grant. We will need to meet in the very near future to discuss this option with both communities and decide on the type of cross section that would be most economical and beneficial to the Village. Storm water management on the Korth property was also discussed and more than likely be addressed in the design phase.
5. Evergreen drainage issues between 4th and 6th:

With the extraordinary amount of rain we have been having this year and the heavy rains we've had in the past, there have been culvert washouts at 7820 Evergreen (Sandy Weiler's) driveway. She currently has a 36" CMP. It was decided that due to inability to do any chip sealing this year that we should address the north ditch from Sandy's driveway, west to 7862 Evergreen (Keith Fellenz's) lot line. It was recommended to reditch this area. Kris will get some quotes for this project and see about changing from a corrugated metal pipe to a plastic pipe in the correct size.
6. Overall drainage issues between Yellowstone/Hemlock to 6th/4th:

Discussion ensued on the overall drainage issues within this area. Several things were noted such as the water not being able to overflow south along the west ditch line at the intersection of 4th and Evergreen and how the ditches have been filled in within this area. One common theme kept recurring and that was that the discharge at the south end of the Village limits just east of 5th Street needed to be cleaned out again. Mike Draxler will research regulatory issues to see if we can get something resolved with this issue.
7. Discussion on 5-Year Road Construction and Maintenance Plan.

The Roads Committee has come up with the following 5-year plan:

2018 – Overlay Blacktop Wedge Coat on Mclean Lane from Main to dead end

 - Chip Seal Fourth Street from Yellowstone Drive to Evergreen Street
 - Chip Seal Evergreen Street from Fourth Street to Fifth Street
 - Chip Seal West Ninth Street from Fir Street to Hemlock Street
 - Chip Seal West Tenth Street from Fir Street to Hemlock Street

2019 - Reconstruct Yellowstone Drive

- 2020 - Chip Seal West Seventh Street from Fir Street to Hemlock Street
 - Chip Seal West Eight Street from Fir Street to Hemlock Street
 - Chip Seal Cedar Street and Butternut Street
 - Chip Seal Hemlock Street from Ninth Street to Eleventh Street

- 2021 - Chip Seal West Seventh Street from Fir Street to Hemlock Street
 - Chip Seal West First Street
 - Chip Seal West Second Street

2022 - To be discussed at the next meeting (the five year plan is tentative for now)

8. Other business:

Discussion ensued on hiring another helper for miscellaneous tasks throughout the Village. Kris said there may be a few who may be interested and he will pursue their interest and present to the board for their consideration.
